Notes:

1. Electricity use and maximum demand have been defined for typical customers. Thus, the average prices calculated reflect the price of each typical customer located in different countries. Analysis is based on published tariffs. Whether the tariffs are cost-reflective or not and whether the utilities are profitable or loss making, has not been considered.
2. Sales taxes such as 'VAT' are **not included**. Fuel surcharges, if any, **are included**. For Assam, Kerala and Maharashtra, '*Electricity Duty*' is **included**. Subsidised rates are included for Tamilnadu.
3. These are based on published tariffs. Special concessions given to identified customers or within special economic zones are not included.
4. Optional tariffs (such as time-of-use, TOU) are not included. When TOU tariffs are mandatory, a flat load profile has been assumed.
5. Unity power factor is assumed, where relevant.
6. Prices updated as of 7th Oct 2015.

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
